

Using the Immersive Reader Tool in Canvas

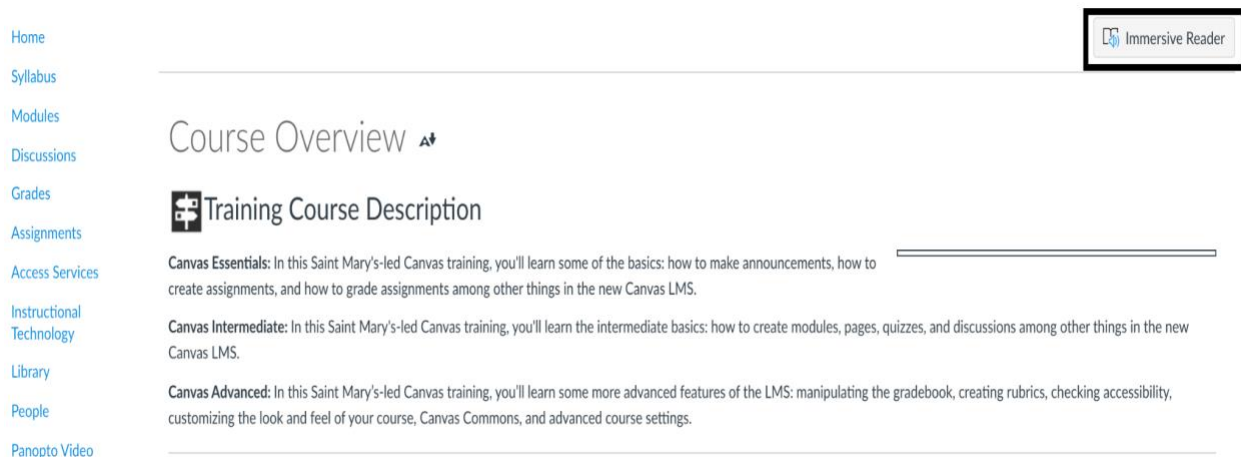
The Immersive Reader enhances your reading experience by improving accessibility and boosting reading comprehension.

The Immersive Reader displays a variety of tools and options to enhance your reading experience.

You can manage text, grammar, and reading preferences using the toolbar. You can hear the page text read aloud and adjust various audio settings. Additionally there are translation and definition services available as well.

Activating the Immersive Reader

On any page in Canvas, click the Immersive Reader button in the upper right corner of the window.

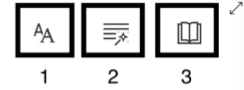

When in the Immersive Reader window there are five (5) tools at your fingertips.

1. Text Preferences: Customize font, text size, color, and other themes.
2. Grammar Options: Set syllables and parts of speech
3. Reading Preferences: Translation and dictionary settings.
4. Screen reading settings: Activation and Voice settings.
